

## **PART II : EVALVATIVE REPORT**

### **1. Executive summary of the Institution**

The Sai Shyam College of Education is an offshoot of Sai Shyam Educational Society established in the year 2002. The society is registered under Societies Registration Act. The college of education is recognised by J&K Government and is affiliated to the University of Jammu, which admits the B.Ed. students, conducts the examination and awards the degrees. The college got NAAC Accreditation in the year 2008 and is also ISO 9001:2000 certified. Besides the college also provides two years E.T.T. course. For the benefit of the Pupil Teachers, the Sai Shyam Educational Society has been also started a Public High School. The College is situated amidst deep rural background, environmentally rich with calm and quiet atmosphere. Magnificent buildings with fully equipped classrooms, labs etc. have been provided in a well laid campus amidst the groves of trees about 14Km away from the Jammu University Campus, carefully mustered by the dedicated teaching faculty, administrators and members of the management.

The mission of Sai Shyam College of Education is to uplift the society by bringing awareness among men and women folk. The institution is dedicated to help men and women to be moral, self reliant, self sufficient, self dependent and adjust to the world senario. Our motto is morality and productivity. The above mentioned management committee of the college approves the budget for each session, selects the teaching faculty and other non-teaching staff of the college. The managing committee of the college also holds meetings twice in a year to chalk out the strategies for the quality education and for enrichment of the Infrastructure qualitatively and quantitatively.

The Practice of Teaching is organised in local schools (both Govt./Private) selected by the college and approved by the Chief education Officer, Jammu which are mostly within the vicinity of the college. The college arranges a system of team supervision in which each college faculty member is given responsibility of supervising a fixed number of pupil teachers. The college has a close academic and professional relationship with the selected number of practicing schools where Head of the institution provide active participation and bless the pupil-teacher with new innovations introduced in their schools.

Besides, good library facilities are also available to help pupil-teachers to overcome (meet) their academic needs. In the light of this, the college also invites the heads of the schools and some of their teachers to attend various educational programmes. This strengthens the liaison between the college and the practicing schools, which by and large has great utility for the students and also the community as a whole.

The college aims to start new self financed and professional courses in the near future. **Threats**

1. In J&K State B.Ed is not essential for the appointment of the teacher, both in Govt. & Non-Govt. sectors hence the number of local aspirants is less. Moreover the inflow of students from outside the state has also dwindled resulting in decrease in enrolment of students. It poses a threat of closure to B.Ed. colleges in J&K State.
2. Insecurity due to non-permanent affiliation to institution by the University of Jammu.
